The SW Herts Admissions Consortium comprises the eight secondary schools in the area which operate admission tests for a proportion of their intake.

If you are considering applying for a place for your child at Parmiter's, Queens', Rickmansworth, Bushey Meads, St Clement Danes, Watford Grammar School for Boys, Watford Grammar School for Girls and Croxley Danes School you will need to register with the SW Herts Consortium before Friday 16th June 2017.

The website for registering your son or daughter with the Consortium is now open and will remain accessible until Friday 16th June and you can register your child at any time in that period.

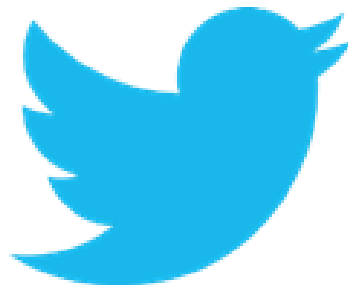
