

THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

Communication and Language:

- We will continue to use our Communication and Language assessment tool to check the children's spoken language and also their understanding.
- Listen to a traditional tale on the IWB.

Physical Development:

- Changing for PE and putting our school uniform back on again!
- Daily Mile on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.
- In the hall we will all act out the story of the Little Red Hen together to help us understand what to do later in the week when we act the story in a small group.

Literacy Development:

- In phonics: continuing to work on environmental sounds and identifying an animal from a set of clues and guessing what is inside a container by the sound it makes when shaken.
- Drawing a picture of something that happens in the Little Red Hen story and they doing some emergent writing about what we have drawn. (Emergent writing is just where the children pretend to write and make marks on their paper that mean something to them).

Mathematical Development:

- Reading numbers as appropriate for each child. We will then choose a number we can read and count that number of beads onto a string or put the correct number of toys into a saucer. We will try to stop at the number we want!

Understanding of the World:

- On Thursday we will have French with Mrs Neil.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Acting out the story of The Little Red Hen in a group of 4 trying to remember the words from the story.
