

# THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

## Communication and Language:

- We will be trying to listen to instructions when making bread rolls.
- We will use our Communication and Language assessment tool to check the children's spoken language and also their understanding.

## Physical Development:

- Changing for PE and continuing to play the two games we started last week called 'traffic lights' and 'rabbits'!
- Daily Mile on Tuesday and Thursday mornings.

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- On Tuesday we will be making bread. This was planned for last week but other activities took longer to complete than expected. We will focus on taking turns and sharing resources as well as talking about the ingredients and what yeast does when we add it to the mixture.

## Literacy Development:

- In phonics: continuing to work on environmental sounds. We will be identifying sounds on a sound lotto game and identifying sounds made behind a screen such as keys, bells etc.

## Mathematical Development:

- Using the number line to count how many children we have in school each morning and counting the same number using our fingers.

## Understanding of the World:

- On Thursday we will be having an International Day for the whole school. The country for the EYFS is France. We will rotate around activities including singing songs from different countries, food tasting, making flags for the country of France and trying to copy some French words.
