

THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

Communication and Language:

- Listening to a traditional tale on the IWB.

Physical Development:

- Walking in different ways, staying in our own space when walking and describing how it feels to walk on our heels, balls, toes and soles of our feet.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Hands Are Not For Hitting: thinking about how it feels to be hit by one of our friends and talking about all the things our hands can do in Nursery. Making hand prints to show what our hands can do.

Literacy Development:

Mathematical Development:

- Counting out the correct number of unifix to match a number and stopping at the correct number.
- Using the language of 'more' and 'a lot' when playing with 2 groups of sorting toys.
