Spellings

Your child will have already received their spelling sheet. I have posted a copy in our home learning page.

The children are to choose their challenge of how many spellings they will learn. If you wish them to learn more, then this is absolutely fine.

The children should then complete a minimum of 8 sentences in their spelling homework book using their chosen words. The sentences should be complex using a range of vocabulary. The spelling test will take place on the following Friday. Their new words will be set then.

Our key spelling focus for this week will be focusing on silent letters.

Topic

This week, we will be finishing our work on the Antarctic with a visit from Mr Foster. This will take place on Tuesday afternoon. He will be talking about his trip to the Antarctic.

English

This week, we will be using descriptive sentences to evaluate new Antarctic boots for sale.

The children will also be completing a reading comprehension task to assess their reading.

Mathematics

We will be finishing the unit on perimeter and area as well as completing assessment tasks.
