Spellings

Your child will have already received their spelling sheet. I have posted a copy in our home learning page.

The children are to choose their challenge of how many spellings they will learn. If you wish them to learn more, then this is absolutely fine.

The children should then complete a minimum of 8 sentences in their spelling homework book using their chosen words. The sentences should be complex using a range of vocabulary. The spelling test will take place on the following Friday. Their new words will be set then.

Our key spelling focus for this week will be focusing on the word pattern "ough"

English

This week, we will be using descriptive sentences to describe the Antarctic landscape and thinking about the type of equipment needed for a trip to this harsh environment.

Mathematics

We will be continuing the unit on perimeter and area.

Please feel free to use the Mathletics program at home to support their learning. All the children have their codes in their diaries.

Topic

This week, we will continue our work on landscapes focusing on the way Emperor Penguins adapt to the conditions during the winter months.

Topic homework---To research different animals that are found in the Antarctic and how they have adapted to the harsh conditions.
