Physical Development:

- Completing the daily mile three times this week.

Literacy Development:

- In phonics: working on a section called body percussion. We will perform actions that get quicker and slower, copy a sequence of body sounds and identify sounds we can't see by listening carefully.
- In our reading groups we will be trying to join in with words and phrases that repeat themselves in familiar stories.

Mathematical Development:
