

# THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

## Communication and Language:

- Learning the names of doctors equipment (stethoscope, thermometer, syringe) Playing Kim's game when we look carefully at all the instruments and try to work out which one is missing and use it's correct name, when one is taken away.

## Physical Development:

- Moving around the hall and staying in our own space. Talking about how it feels when walking on different parts of the feet, which was the easiest/hardest way of walking. Pretending to walk in windy weather, in the rain, under a low bridge, along a beach etc.

## Literacy Development:

- In phonics we are working on 'Body Percussion'. We will identify body sounds such as snoring or eating, think about times when we can be quiet or noisy, and use our voice to make sounds that are slow/fast, quiet/loud, long/short.

## Mathematical Development:

- Going on a shape hunt around school and identifying shapes that we find.
- Using the language of quantity (more, less, a lot etc) when counting toys into separate containers.

## Understanding of the World:

- On Thursday we will practising counting to 10 in French
