

THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

Communication and Language:

- Listen to the story of Robin Hood on the IWB.
- We will be listening to the children talk about their Christmas, the presents they got, who came to visit them and what happened on Christmas morning.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Using a tray to make a marble print for the front of our calendars. We drop paint onto paper and tip the tray so the marbles roll through it and cover the paper with a trail in various colours.
- Talking about how Robin Hood helped people and why it is kind to be helpful and thoughtful.

Literacy Development:

- In phonics: working on a section called body percussion. We will perform songs with action and make up actions that match a musical instrument
- Using emergent writing to write a letter to Father Christmas to say thank you for the presents he sent them.
- Listening to the story of Robin Hood in our reading groups and talking about what happened in the story, the characters and where the story took place.

Mathematical Development:

- Looking at the numbers 2019. Talking about calendars and what they are used for.

Understanding of the World:

- Counting to 10 in French.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Painting a picture of Robin Hood.
