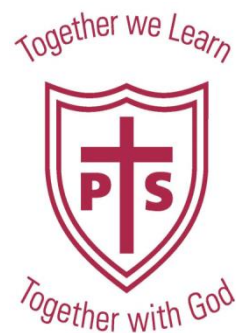

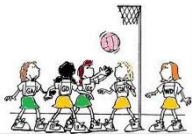
TWIGS – Y1/Y2
