

# THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

## Communication and Language:

- Watching and listening to a traditional story on the IWB and talking about the characters, events and settings in the story.
- Listening to the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar and talking about what happens.

## Physical Development:

- Starting to use small apparatus in the hall to climb on, over and jump off. We will learn how to use the apparatus safely and how to land correctly when we jump.

## Literacy Development:

- In phonics we will be working on voice sounds. We will try to talk like a robot (c-a-t), continue a sound pattern, vary the pitch of the sound and use our voice to add sounds to a story.
- In our reading groups we will be looking at books and trying to predict what happens at the end of the story or on the next page.
- Making our own Very Hungry Caterpillar book.

## Mathematics:

- Counting how many pieces of fruit the caterpillar eats through on each day of the week and making the correct number of fruit prints.
- Talking about the size and shape of the fruit we print with and comparing them.

## Understanding of the World:

- On Thursday we will start to learn the French words for different parts of the body.
- On Friday we will take part in a whole school activity day where we will go to different classes to try lots of different science activities.

## Expressive Arts and Design:

- Painting the front cover of our Very Hungry Caterpillar book.
- Making a leaf with an egg on to explain the start of the story.
- Talking about the different textures of all the fruit we print with.

On Friday it is **Red Nose Day**. All children can come to school wearing something red.
