

THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

Communication and Language:

- Watching and listening to a traditional story on the IWB and talking about the characters, events and settings in the story.

Physical Development:

- Holding our pencil correctly when writing the title of our book.

Literacy Development:

- In phonics we will be finishing our work on voice sounds. We will continue to talk like a robot (c-a-t), continue a sound pattern, vary the pitch of the sound and use our voice to add sounds to a story.
- In our reading groups we will be looking at books and trying to predict what happens at the end of the story or on the next page.
- Copying or tracing over the title 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' on the front of our books and writing our names.

Mathematics:

- Introducing 1 less than by counting on fingers, using the number line and moving objects.

Understanding of the World:

- On Thursday we will continue to learn the French words for different parts of the body. So far we have learnt the French words for head, eyes, mouth and nose
- Spending the second half of Monday morning in the Wellness Woods.
- Learning how to use some new IT equipment. Play mobile phones where the children can contact a friend on another phone by pressing the correct colour button and using the Bee Bots which are programmable toys which will move forward, backwards and turn round.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Making a butterfly print for our Very Hungry Caterpillar books by painting one side of a butterfly, folding the paper over to make a symmetrical pattern.
