

THIS WEEK WE WILL BE:

Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

- Learn about Shrove Tuesday and why it is traditional to eat pancakes.

Communication and Language:

- Watching and listening to a traditional story on the IWB and talking about the characters, events and settings in the story.
- Show an understanding of prepositions under, behind, in front and on top of by identifying the correct cat picture.

Physical Development:

- We will be using our 'Daily Mile' runs to think about the importance of exercise and how exercising makes our body feel. Following our run we will paint a self portrait and write down how the run made us feel.

Literacy Development:

- In phonics we will be working on voice sounds. We will make different sounds with our voice, try to talk like a robot and continue a sound pattern and vary the pitch of the sound.
- In our reading groups we will be looking at books and trying to predict what happens at the end of the story or on the next page.

Mathematics:

- Using shapes of various sizes to make a picture of a cat.

Understanding of the World:

- On Thursday we will practice counting in French to 10, sing Frere Jacques and start to learn the French words for different parts of the body.

Expressive Arts and Design:

- Painting a large cat to go on our classroom door.
