Dear parents,

Your child already has their Purple Mash and Mathletics codes in their diary and they should have brought home their Home Learning workbook.

For the next two weeks, I will be posting the work onto the Year 5 home learning page. The work will be uploaded by 10am each day. I will be able to monitor the work completed on Purple Mash and Mathletics.

In Purple Mash, I will be able to give comments and rewards.

I will also put on the spelling/handwriting sheets.

I have also set up a Class Blog on Purple Mash. Go to Sharing and then Shared Blogs. Click on Mr McDonough to access the Blog. Only the class and I will be able to see it. The children can ask questions and tell me how they are getting on. I thought it would be a nice way to stay in contact with them. All comments will be assessed by me first before posting. Please read their posts before sending.

Each day I will be posting the following tasks.

- A 30min maths activity (This will be linked to Mathletics. If they finish the task, they can go onto Live Mathletics. If they achieve less than 70% for a challenge, I will reset it for the following day as well as the main activities set.
- A 30min reading activity. This will be a reading comprehension task linked to Serial Mash.
- A 30min writing task to be completed in their Home learning book or on Purple Mash. This could also be completed as a word document and stuck into their Home Learning Book.
- A topic activity. This might be a computing task, science task, art task etc.

For my paper learners, they will have their learning folders with all the work inside. I have also given them a maths textbook.

Each day, I will inform them of which Maths page to complete and which comprehension and writing task to complete.
