**Evelyn Mary Dunbar** (18 December 1906 – 12 May 1960) was a British artist, illustrator and teacher.<sup>[1]</sup> She is notable for recording women's contributions to World War II on the United Kingdom home front, particularly the work of the [Women's Land Army](#). She was the only woman working for the [War Artists' Advisory Committee](#) on a full-time salaried basis. Dunbar had a deep devotion to nature and a particular affection for the landscape of [Kent](#).
