

Year 5 Home Learning

Week beginning 19th October 2020

In our maths lessons, we have been looking at decimals and finding compliments to 1 for example: $0.25 + 0.75 = 1$. The children have been using their knowledge of bonds to 100 to help them with this. We have also been looking at converting decimals to fractions. For example: $0.3 = \frac{3}{10}$ or $\frac{30}{100}$.
 $0.45 = \frac{45}{100}$

This week's maths homework is on the home learning page. It is rounding decimals to the nearest whole number.

For this week's spellings we are revisiting all of their spellings for this half term. There is a new set of spellings to revise each day and a quiz on purplemash to accompany this.

In English, we have been looking at instructional writing and before half term, we will be creating our own piece of writing on this. On purplemash, I have assigned a task which asks you to write a set of instructions for a recipe. If your child is keen to write about this then great, perhaps they can even make the food together with you. However, they do not have to write a recipe. If they want to write a set of instructions based on another hobby of theirs, then that is fine too.
