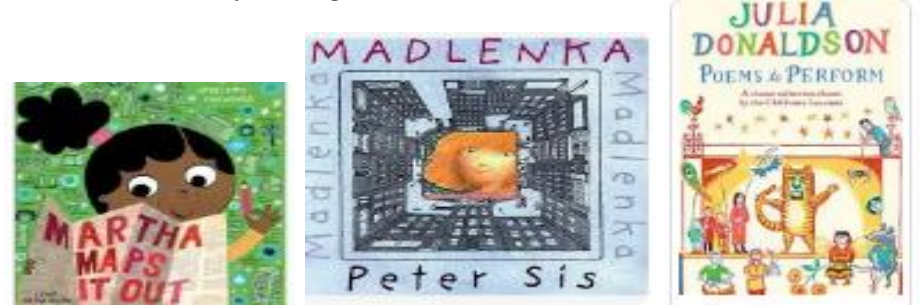
Geography An African Adventure
