Explorer- Someone who goes on a journey to find out about somewhere or something new.

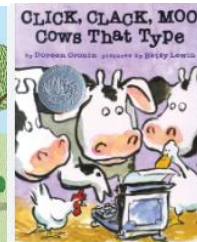
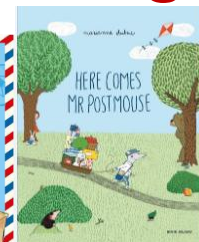
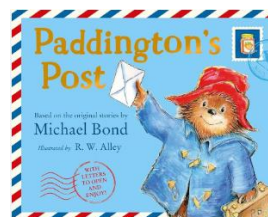
Significant- Important and worth knowing about.
