So many hearts make a school.

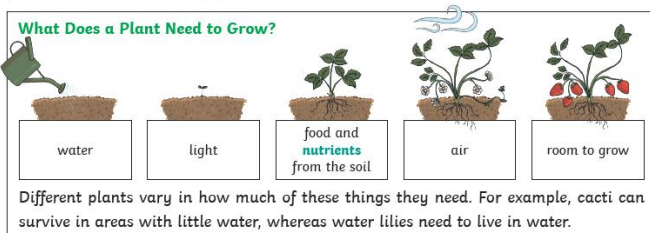
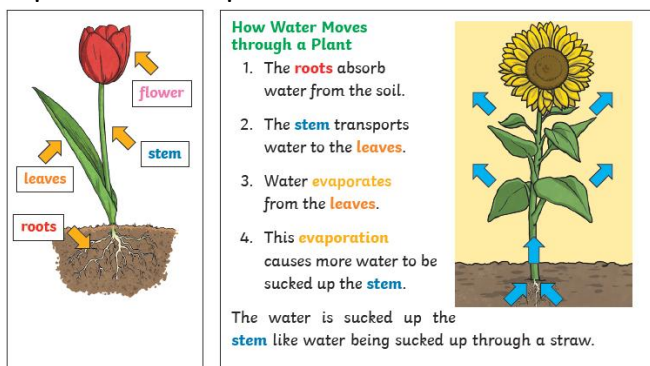

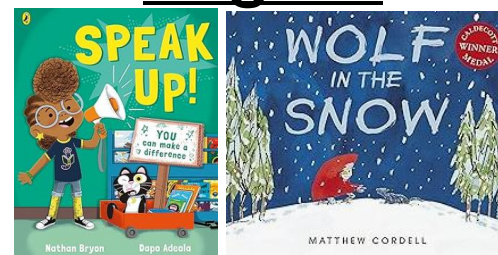
## Science – Plants

## English

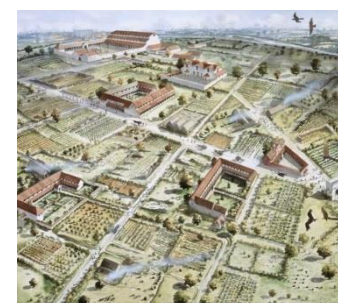


We will be learning about persuasive letters and instructions, developing our skills in organising ideas clearly and choosing language for different purposes.

A disco song about friendship, unity, peace and hope.

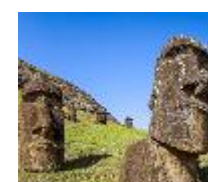


Children will have the opportunity not only to learn about the key values, but to also learn about a new genre of music...Disco!
