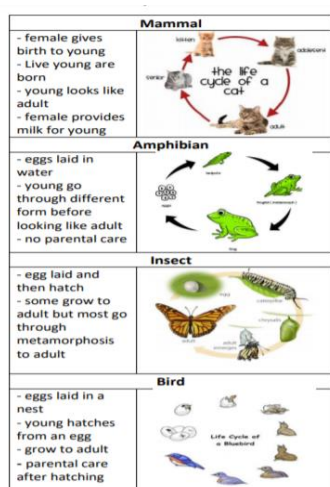
Theme: Sensational South America

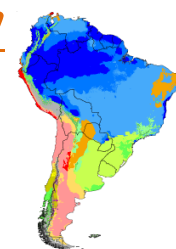
Throughout this unit we will be looking at dialogue and openers within narratives. We will also be looking at biographies and non-chronological report writing.
