So many hearts make a school.

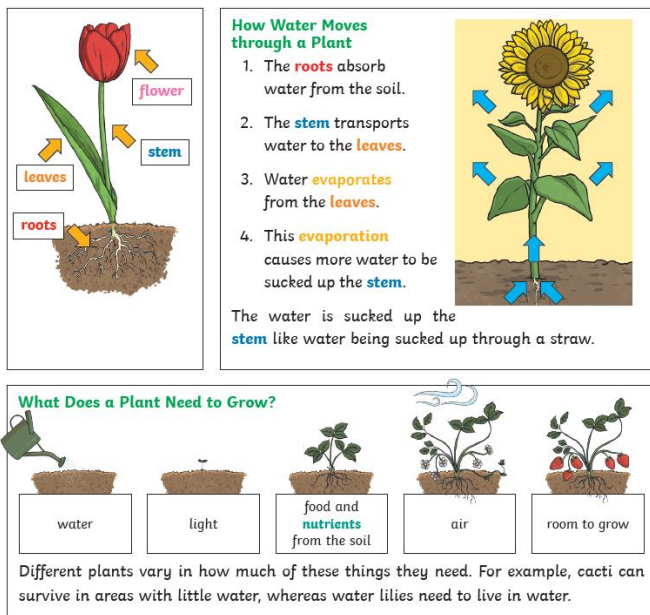

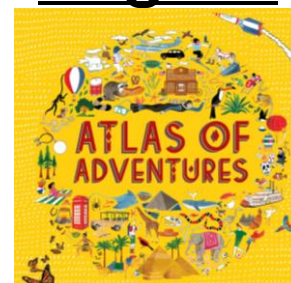
Science – Plants

Children will have the opportunity not only to learn about the key values, but to also learn about a new genre of music...Disco!

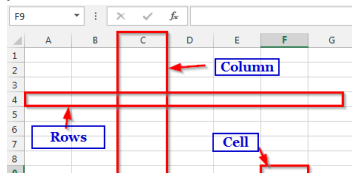
