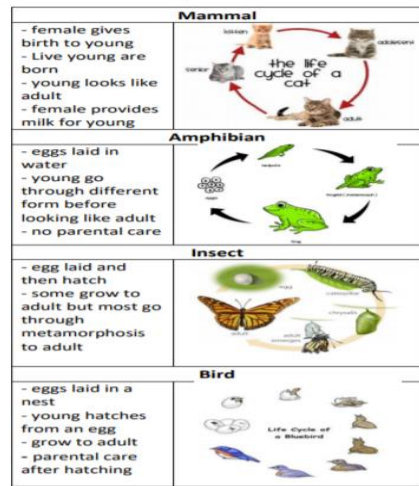
Theme: Sensational South America

- learn about Jane Goodall

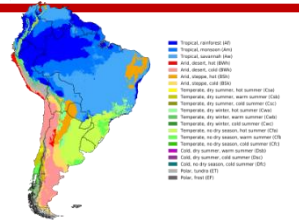


English
