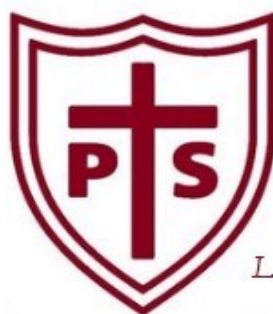

Year 4

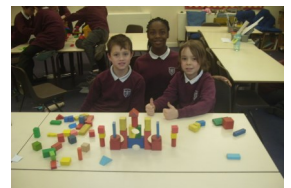
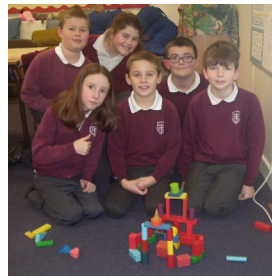
