We will be learning about:

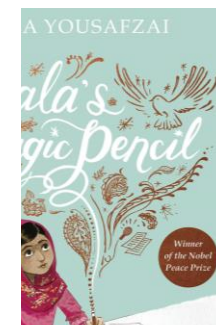
- the different states of matter and how to identify them.

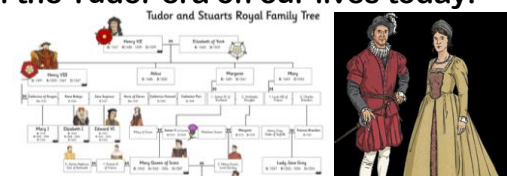
