So many hearts make a school.


Theme: *Climb Every Mountain*

We will be learning to:


- identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system, and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood

The **heart** pumps blood to the lungs to get oxygen. It then pumps this **oxygenated blood** around the body.







Mountains
