So many hearts make a school.

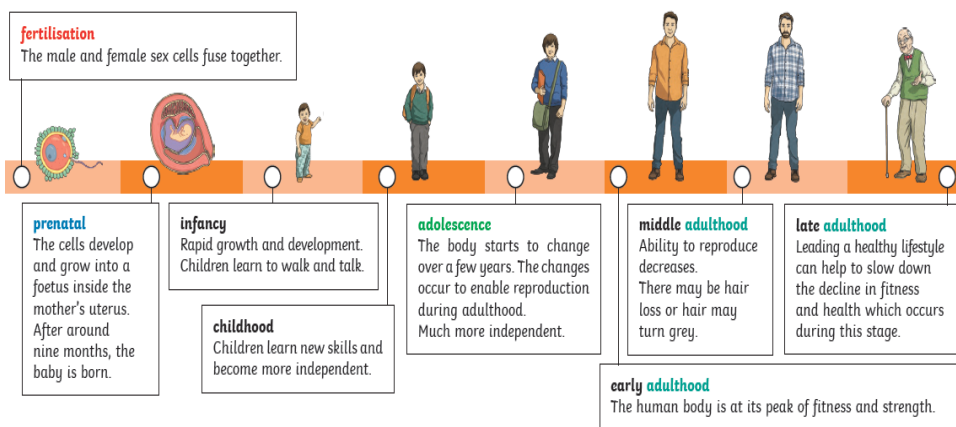


Science – Animals Including Humans

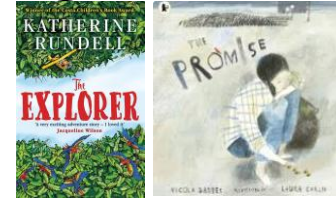
Which is longer: double decker bus or the small intestine?

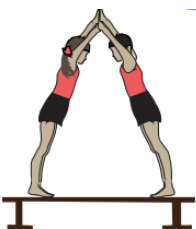
