We are...


Exploring new words linked to worms including long, wiggly, slimy, segment.

We are....

Exploring number and counting rhymes.

Counting and reading from 0-20 and beyond.

Recognising numbers between 0-10 and 10-20 and placing them in order.

Identifying that a whole can be broken into many parts

Using subitising to identify multiple parts within a given whole

Running the 'Daily Mile'.

Exploring ways of controlling a ball through pushing rolling, tapping and throwing it with our hands.
