

Talking about what we need to stay healthy and grow.</p> <p>Exploring healthy eating and the importance of eating a balanced diet.</p> <p>Using child friendly one-handed tools to wash and prepare fruit and vegetables for a salad.</p> <p>Talking about the importance of washing our hands after handling soil, planting and before eating.</p> 	<p>We will be... Reading and ordering numbers from 0 to 10 or 20 and beyond.</p> <p>Saying a number that is one more or one less than a given number.</p> <p>Counting objects to match given numbers.</p> <p>Counting irregular arrangements of objects.</p> <p>Exploring the concept of doubling and halving.</p> <p>Counting on or back from a given number.</p> <p>Exploring addition and subtraction problems.</p> <p>Naming and describing the properties of 2D and 3D shapes.</p>	<p>We will be... Finding out about the life cycle of a plant.</p> <p>Talking about how to care for plants and what plants need to grow.</p> <p>Growing bean plants and cress.</p> <p>Planting grass seeds in seed trays and keep them under different conditions. Talking about how well each set of grass grew and why.</p> <p>Investigating plants, flowers, fruits and vegetables from other countries, locating countries on the globe.</p>	<p>We will be... Using leaves to print onto paper and clay.</p> <p>Thickening paint by adding flour and then applying the paint using fingers or lolly sticks to produce sunflower paintings in the style of Van Gogh.</p> <p>Creating a 'Garden Centre' role-play area.</p> <p>Design and build our own models using reclaimed materials,</p>
