


Personal, Social and Emotional development

Literacy

We are...


Reading the traditional tale of 'Jack and the Beanstalk'.
Talking about the characters, setting and main events in our story.
Writing a letter from Jack to the giant.
Exploring rhyming strings.
Reading and sequencing events in the story.
Continuing to revise all the phonemes we have learned so far, spotting them in new words we read and using them when writing.
Reading our own individual reading books - please read your 'Bug Club' books at home too.



Communication and Language

We are...

Asking our own questions about plants to develop our knowledge and understanding of them.
Exploring words linked to plants including leaf, stem, roots, seed, flower, fruit.
Using talk to describe the character of 'Jack and the Giant'.

Mathematics

We are....

Exploring number and counting rhymes.
Recognising numbers between 0-10 and 10-20 and counting out the correct number of objects to match each number.
Finding one more or one less than a given number between 0 and 20.
Exploring numbers 11-20 as 'Ten and some more'
Exploring the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

Physical development

We are..

Running the 'Daily Mile'.
Learning to negotiate space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.
Exploring daily 'Busy Finger' activities to build our finger muscles.
Continuing to handle different tools, including pencils and scissors, with increasing control.
Using gardening tools safely and with increasing control in the outside area.

Expressive arts and design

We are.....

Creating stained glass windows and other props to use in our new church role play area.
Colour mixing using paint.
Creating observational drawings and paintings of plants.

Understanding the world

We are..

Observing a range of plants and naming the different parts of them.
Exploring the different plants in our garden and learning the names of some of them.
Planting beans and talking about what is needed to make them grow.
