## Literacy

We are...

Reading the story of 'Jasper's Beanstalk' by Nick Butterworth.

Creating our own story maps of the story.

Writing instructions on how to plant a bean.

Writing our own diary, just like Jasper did in the story.

Labelling parts of a beanstalk.

Continuing to revise all the phonemes we have learned so far, spotting them in new words we read and using them when writing.

Reading our own individual reading books - please read your 'Bug Club' books at home too.

## Communication and Language

We are...

Retelling the story and talking about what Jasper did on each day of the week.


Talking about why we think Jasper is looking for giants at the end of the story and if we think he will find one.

## Mathematics

We are....

Exploring number and counting rhymes.

Recognising numbers between 0-10 and 11-20 and counting out the correct number of objects to match each number.

Finding one more or one less than a given number between 0 and 20.

Exploring numbers 11-20 as 'Ten and some more' Matching numbers to number words e.g. 15 and fifteen.

## Physical development

We are..

Running the 'Daily Mile'.

Learning to negotiate space successfully when playing racing and chasing games with other children, adjusting speed or changing direction to avoid obstacles.

Exploring daily 'Busy Finger' activities to build our finger muscles.

Using gardening tools safely and with increasing control in the outside area.

Talking about hygiene practices before and after handling soil and plants.

## Expressive arts and design

We are.....

Creating images of what we would like to find at the top of a beanstalk.

Colour mixing to create different shades of green.

Creating observational drawings and paintings of plants.



## Understanding the world

We are..

Going on a 'Leaf hunt' to find different shapes, sizes and colours of leaves.

Looking and talking about the life cycle of a bean.

Planting beans and talking about what is needed to make them grow healthy.
